Registration for Fun Dog Show

Registration is £2 per category entered (all proceeds to the Poppy Appeal).

Entrants do not have to be residents of Arborfield, Barkham & District.

Entrants must agree to abide by the competition rules.

The registration form must be completed in full. All forms will be destroyed following the event. Registration fees must be paid in full before the start of the class entered.

Payment

Payment in cash please. Payment will be taken from 10:30 on the day of the show up until 30 minutes before the start of the class.

Judging:

Judge's Rights:

Judges' decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into and prizes cannot be exchanged.

Infectious Disease

Please do not bring your dog if it has been in contact with infectious disease in the last 6 weeks. Pups under 6 months, bitches in season and anti-social dogs are ineligible for this show

Rules, Health & Safety:

- No Bitches in season
- No Anti-Social Dogs are eligible for this show
- Dogs (except Guide dogs) are not permitted into the Main Buildings
- Dog owners must be responsible for their dogs at all times
- Whilst on the premises, dogs should remain on the lead and be under the owner's control and supervision at all times
- Water will be available for your dog
- Please take care of your dog: Your dog is AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm.
- If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
- All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst care will be taken the show management will not accept responsibility for loss damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property at the show.
- Dog biscuits will be available to all dog's entered in the Dog Show. The owner takes full responsibility for the offering of biscuits to their dog.
- No dogs under the age of 6 months are permitted to enter

You may be asked to leave if

- Your dog exhibits aggressive behaviour
- You fail to pick up your dog's poo
- The organisers see harsh or unacceptable treatment of a dog
- You, your dog, family or guest's behaviour is considered unacceptable
